Nordre Hammer

Torkild Olsen is one of the earlier owners of Nordre Hammer. He came from Tuddal in Telemark, he was a teacher, was a postman for many years, was municipal treasurer for a few years, treasurer in Lørenskog Sparebank for 33 years and a member of the church authority.

His son, Johan Hammer, was a blacksmith, and a very good violin maker and player. Very few knew so many stories about what happened in the old times. Johan Hammer has made the fence around Olavskilden.

The buildings at Nordre Hammer may be from around 1863. In 1954, the buildsa consisted of: Farmhouse, outbuilding and food storage. The old farmhouse was originally moved from Østmork. After 1954 the following changes have been made to Nordre Hammer: The old log barn was torn down and the storage house moved in connection with the building of a new farmhouse in 1999.

Area and livestock in 1954: 8,5 hektar cultivated land and 0,5 hektar pasture, 2 horses, 10 cattle and 2 pigs. Area and livestock in 2018: 6,4 hektar cultivated land and 4 hektar uncultivated land. – no animals.



Of the Hammer farms, only on Nordre Hammer where there are famers decending from the family in 1857. Before the Hammer farm was split up, the family originate from 1739.
